ACCOMMODATION : Host family, full board.

SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

New Zealand is home to extreme sports, spectacular scenery, friendly people and world class education. The College is located on the northern edge of the greater Auckland city. It offers sporting **and performing arts opportunities** as well as modern facilities. The College is recognized nationally for excellent academic achievements. It provides international students with a safe and caring environment. Students enjoy the full range of academic, sporting and cultural activities available and are encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities such as Sports, Music and Arts. Classes start in February and finish in December.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

The educational system is divided in 3 levels : the Primary School (Ages 5 - 11), the Intermediate School (Ages 11 - 13) and the Secondary School (Ages 13 - 18). The College offers classes to students from Year 9 to Year 13 (secondary school). In Year 9 and 10, there will be 5 classes scheduled (English, Mathematics, Sciences, Social Studies, and Physical Education) ; students choose 2 more classes from a range of elective subjects. During the year 11, they may choose a larger number of subjects but Mathematics, English and Sciences remain compulsory. During the last 2 years, students have access to a wide range of electives subjects and no subjects are compulsory anymore. International students are generally eligible for the Year 13 level although they may study classes at either Year 12 or 13, depending on their experience and English competency.

ARRIVAL AND ORIENTATION

Transfer from Auckland airport to the host family. Orientation is held by the school staff on arrival for January and July intakes.

REQUIREMENTS

Students must be interviewed in their home country before being accepted. A minimum of 2 years of English study and good academic results are required. An ESOL test is taken during the first week of the program.

SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

The school, located in Christchurch, the largest city in the South Island of New Zealand, welcomes 1600 local students and around 100 international students. Students are attracted to the region by the scenic beauty of the South Island, and a picturesque garden and riverside city landscape. Christchurch has a safe and clean city environment. The school is well known throughout New Zealand for academic excellence and its **arts and music programmes**. It also particularly emphasises on **outdoor education** : from February to April, kayaking can be offered ; from May to June tramping and rock climbing ; and from July to September climbing and snow craft, whereas October and November are dedicated to mountain biking. Rock bands, orchestra, jazz, dance groups, local and national sporting competitions are part of the school tradition and culture. Classes start in February and finish in December.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

The educational system is divided in 3 levels : the Primary School (Ages 5 - 11), the Intermediate School (Ages 11 - 13) and the Secondary School (Ages 13 - 18) -see above-. The school has a broad subject base with students typically studying English and five subjects of their choice. From Year 12, students may specialise in Arts, Sciences, Foreign Languages (French and Spanish available), Social Sciences or Technology. Year 13 is the graduation year with examinations for University Entrance held during November. An intensive English language programme is available for students without the English ability to manage in mainstream subjects.

ARRIVAL

Transfer from Christchurch airport to the host family.

Orientation is held by the school staff on arrival for January and July intakes.

REQUIREMENTS

Students must be interviewed in their home country before being accepted. A minimum of 2 years of English study and good academic results are required. An IELTS or TOEFL test is needed to produce evidence of English proficiency for Year 13 ; for all other years, an English test is held on arrival.
